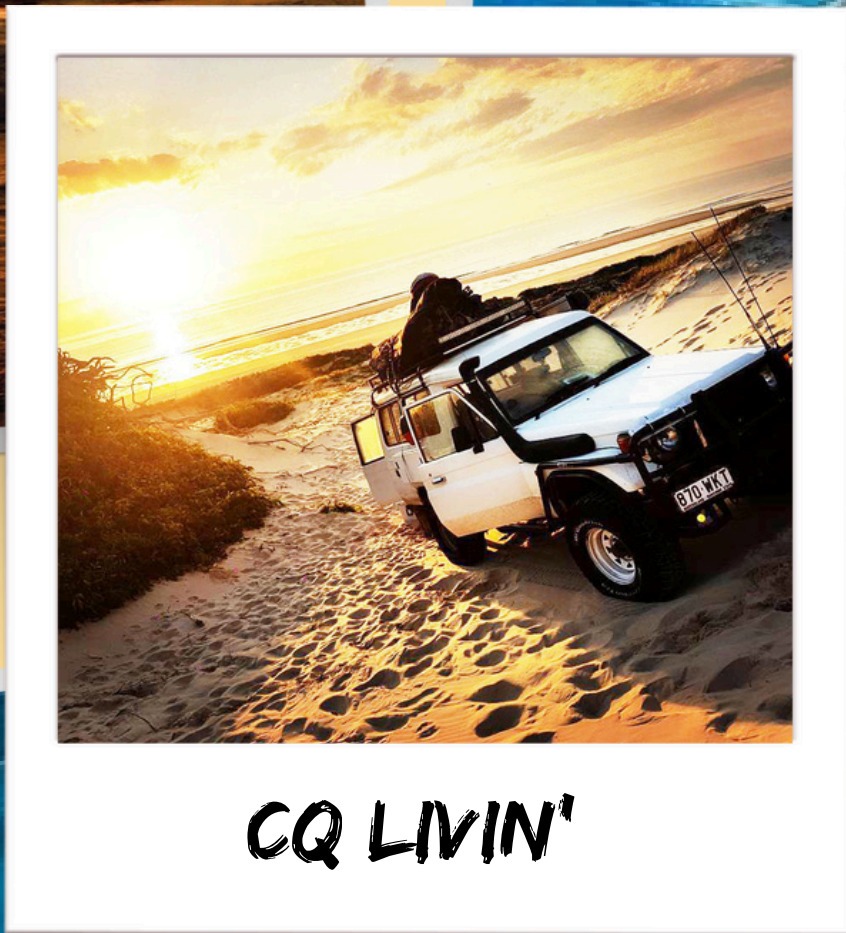

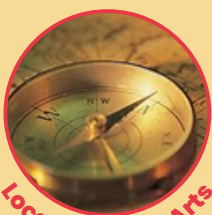

Dare to Jump?

With a short hike through an array of rocks and river, this place is something different to the beaches and island. 60ks from Gladstone show us how daring you are with jumping from the top of the ridge!

Keep you eyes peeled for Captain Cook

A small coastal town not far from Gladstone, this town is built on the site of the second landing in Australia by James Cook and the crew of the bark HMS Endeavour in May 1770. With many beautiful beaches, beach pubs and resorts, where the locals treat you like family and the fish are colourful this is one not to miss.



Take a 4wd to see some hidden gems

Kroombit Tops began forming about 215 million years ago when volcanoes erupted and a great circular caldera, or crater, about 40km across collapsed beneath them. Standing about 900m above surrounding areas to the east, the weather it experiences is much cooler and wetter—a 'temperate island' in the subtropics. Temperatures are generally 5 to 10°C cooler than the surrounding lowlands and can be quite cold in winter, especially at night.



Relaxed, Sun Kissed and Refreshed

If you thought you'd seen it all, you thought wrong. Yeppoon is a popular little town on the coast just north of Rockhampton, with the most amazing manmade water precinct along the beachside. If you're not happy staying on land, load up your snorkel and head to Kepple Island from here for the day (or longer) and see what amazing wildlife swims there.



Campers Dream

89ks from Gladstone this hidden gem is a must see. From 4WD, cooling off, fishing and camping along the river to playing ball in the open space, fires, toilets and fresh water, it really is a beautiful spot.

Southern Great Barrier Reef

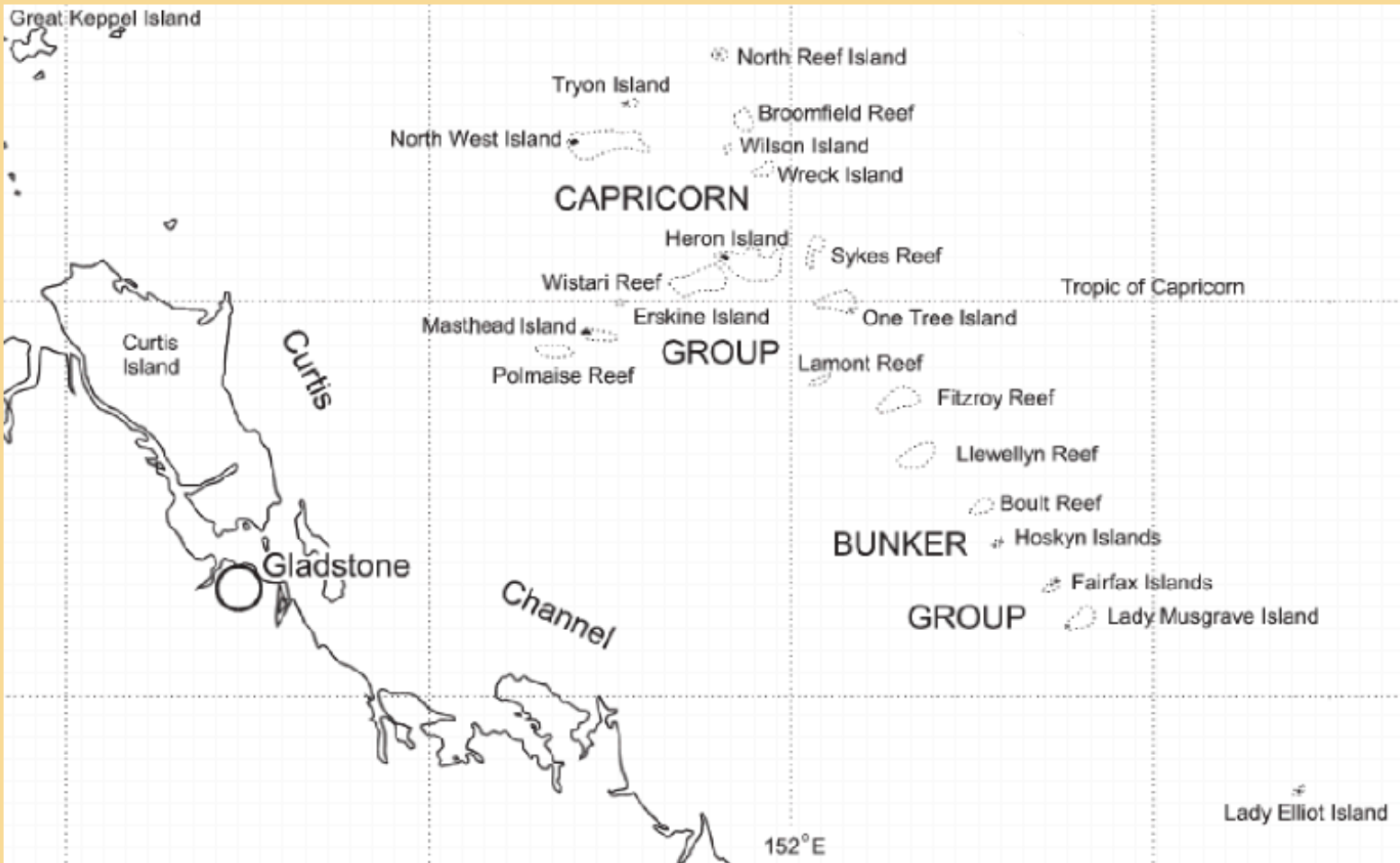
Heron Island is a coral cay located near the Tropic of Capricorn in the southern Great Barrier Reef, 80 kilometres north-east of Gladstone. Supporting around 900 of the 1,500 fish species and 72% of the coral species found on the Great Barrier Reef. During the summer months Heron Island is also home to over 200,000 birds including Noddy Terns and Mutton Birds and is know for it's Turtles.



Traditional Country Camping

437ks from Gladstone. this beauty is hidden in the rugged ranges of Queensland's central highlands. Carnarvon Gorge features towering sandstone cliffs, vibrantly coloured side gorges, diverse flora and fauna and Aboriginal rock art.

Capricorn & Bunker Group - Islands



The Capricorn and Bunker group of islands of the southern Great Barrier Reef lies between 45km and 75km (28 miles and 47 miles) from the adjacent departure ports and urban centres of Yeppoon, Gladstone, Town of 1770 and Bundaberg.

The Capricorn and Bunker groups (including Lady Elliot Island and Reef) are a distinct group of 22 reefs straddling the Tropic of Capricorn, at the southern end of the Great Barrier Reef. There are 16 permanent coral cays on these reefs, including twin cays on Hoskyn and Fairfax Reefs. North West Island (105 hectare) is the largest coral cay in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park.

The islands have high natural values, notably breeding populations of seabirds, marine turtles and coral cay vegetation.

Capricorn Group

The Capricorn Group of islands consists of nine coral cays:

North Reef Island
Tryon Island
North West Island
Wilson Island
Wreck Island
Masthead Island
Erskine Island
Heron Island
One Tree Island

Additional to these are several reef structures separate from the individual island but still part of the Capricorn Group of islands including

Sykes Reef - 23.4331°N 152.0325°W
Wistari Reef - 23.4719°N 151.8819°W
Polmaise Reef - 23.5533°N 151.6828°W
Fitzroy Lagoon Reef - 23.6136°N 152.1594°W
Llewellyn Reef - 23.6922°N 152.1836°W
Lamont Reef - 23.6°N 152.0489°W

Broomfield Reef - 23.2672°N 151.4416°W (possibly with a sandbank or an unvegetated cay)

A tourist Resort and Marine Scientific Research Station have been established on Heron Island. A manned lighthouse operates at North Island and the Australian Museum conducts a field research station on One Tree Island.

Fairfax Islands, (East Fairfax & West Fairfax)
Hoskyn Islands (East and West Hoskyn islands)

Fares

How to calculate your fare?

Fares are calculated based on the number of zones you travel through during your journey.

To calculate your fare, subtract the lowest zone you have travelled in or through, from the highest zone you have travelled in or through, and add one zone.

This will determine the correct number of zones you will be charged.

Ticketing info

Translink single:

One-way ticket to reach your destination, including transfers within two hours on any Translink service.

Translink daily:

Unlimited travel within the zones purchased until the last service scheduled on the day of issue, valid on all Translink services.

Translink weekly:

Unlimited travel within the zones purchased for one week (seven consecutive days) from the date of issue, valid on all Translink services.

Timetable information

How to read this timetable

1. Use the route map to the two timing points your stop is located between.
2. Find these points on the timetable. Your bus is scheduled to arrive between the times shown for these points. For example, if your bus stop is situated between timing points ⑤ and ① on the map, then the bus is scheduled to arrive between the times listed for ⑤ and ①.

Please be advised that the times shown are approximate. We ask that passengers be at the bus stop no less than five minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

Travel tips

1. Pre-plan your trip with **MyTranslink** app, visit translink.com.au or call 1312 30.
2. If you have a concession card, have it ready to show the driver.
3. Read the number top right on the approaching bus to check it's the service you want.
4. Raise your hand to signal to the driver that you want the bus to stop.
5. On the bus, find your seat. If you need to stand, hold on to a handle.
6. Ring the bell to let the driver know your stop is next, and remain seated until the bus stops.
7. Wait for the bus to move away and check the road is clear before crossing the road. If you are within 20m of a designated crossing, you must use that crossing.

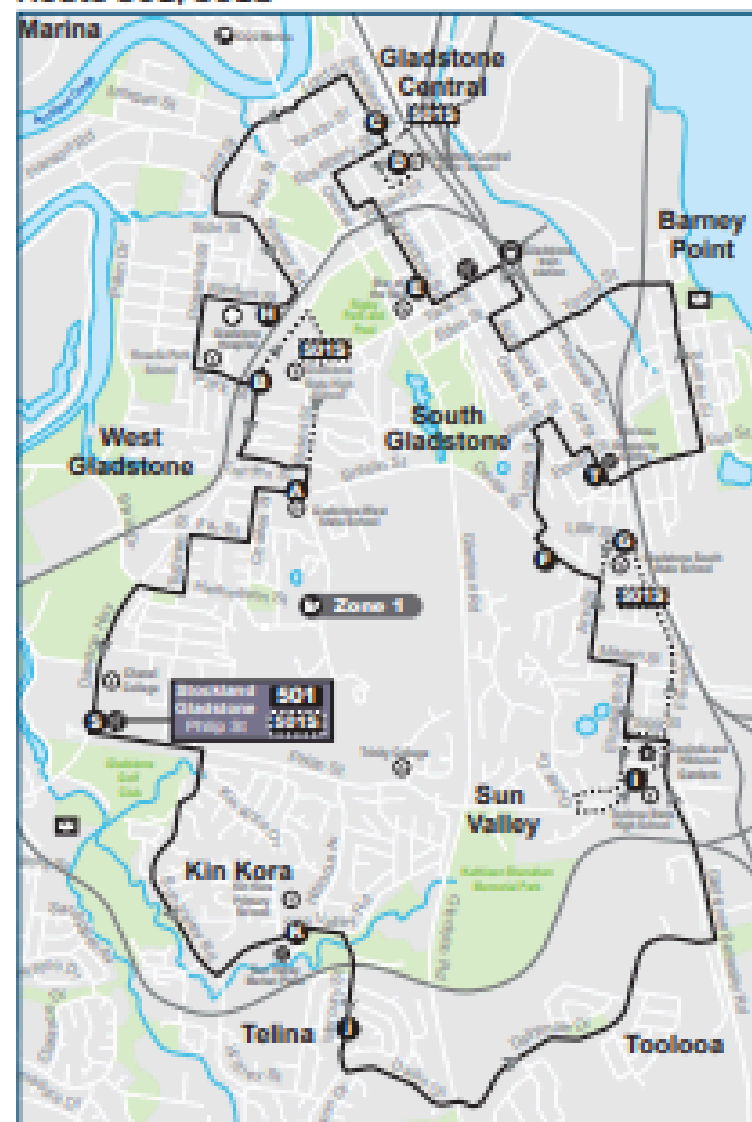

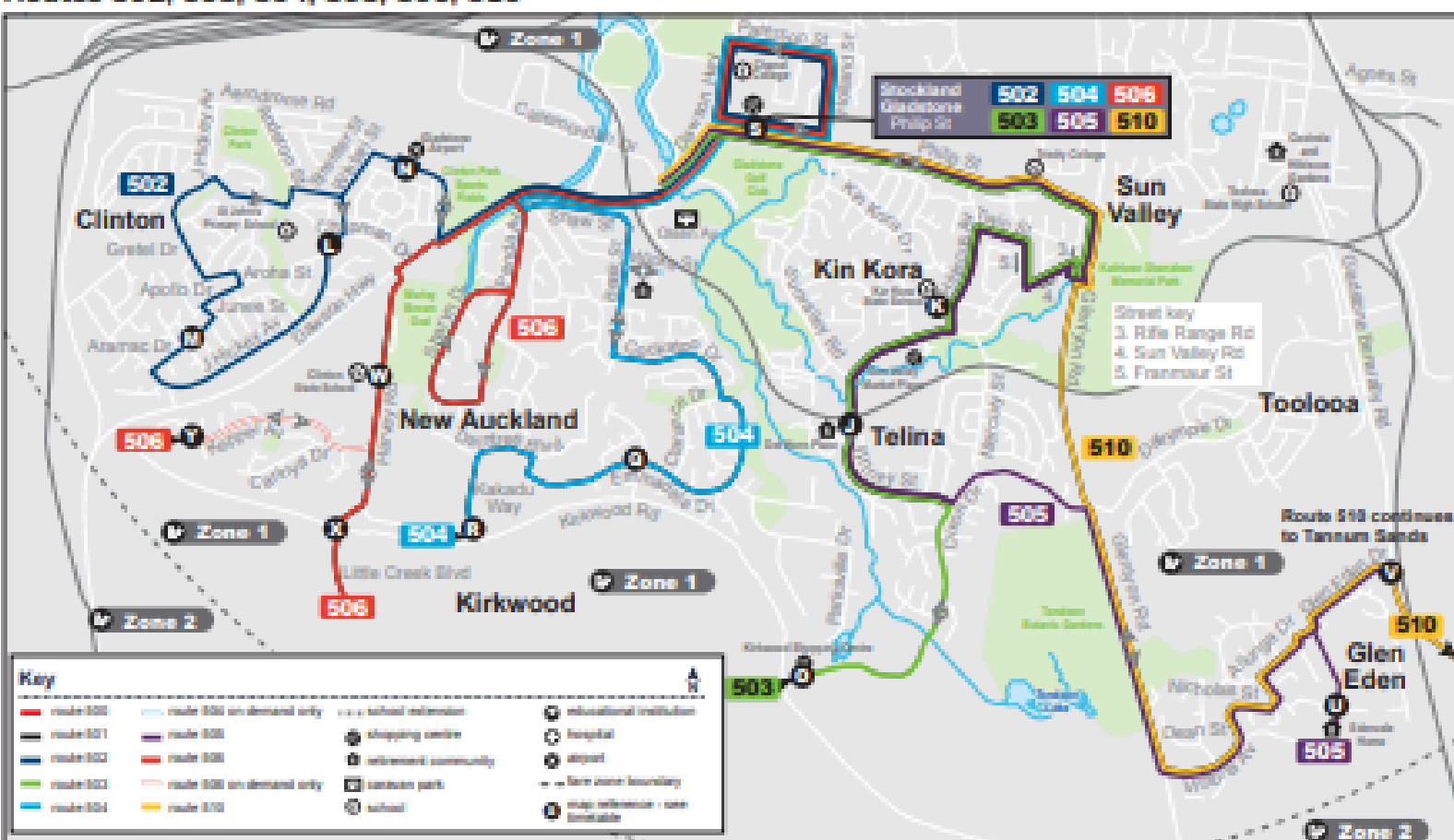
